### What happens during Phase II?

- ◆ The Home and Visiting Teams will be divided among the 3 focus areas.

- ◆ Each focus area will prioritize their list of possible projects to identify the top 3 projects they would like to develop further.
- ◆ Home and Visiting Team members will work together to develop an action plan for each focus area's highest priority projects.
- ◆ All work completed by the end of Phase II will be presented at a town hall meeting.
- ◆ Over the next couple months, the Visiting Team will create a written report summarizing the results of Phase II.

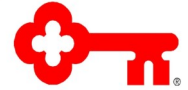
