

Business Spotlight:



Habitat for Humanity Idaho Falls Area – an independent, locally run, nonprofit organization governed by a board of directors made up of community members. Habitat Idaho Falls coordinates all aspects of Habitat home building and repair: fundraising; building site selection; partner family selection, approval and support; house construction; and mortgage lending.

Habitat for Humanity is not a give-away program. Habitat's motto is "a hand up, not a hand out". In addition to a down payment and the small monthly mortgage payments, homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor – sweat equity – into building their Habitat homes and homes of others. To be accepted into the program, the partner family must apply, demonstrate need, show repayment ability for the no-interest loan, and show a willingness to partner. Families are selected without regard to race, color, sex, creed, familial status, disability or national origin.

Habitat for Humanity Idaho Falls Area has completed a total of thirty-nine new construction and seven rehab homes. In addition to home construction Habitat Idaho Falls' A Brush with Kindness (ABWK) program, supported by Valspar Paint, helps communities come together to revitalize aging neighborhoods.

Thanks to a generous donation from the *Kandler Family*, Habitat for Humanity Idaho Falls Area has funding set aside to build and repair homes in Ashton. To date, Habitat for Humanity has built or refurbished six homes within the city limits of Ashton and has several properties set aside to continue building into the future. This year, with the help of construction site manager Vern Johnson, Habitat for Humanity is building a new construction four bedroom, two bath home for a local Ashton family. This home, located at 689 Pine Street, is currently in need of volunteers to help with the insulation, taping and texturing of the drywall. As construction continues Vern will need the community's help with siding, painting and landscaping. 
