# Ashton Archives

The City of Ashton is not the only place where you find progress in motion. The *Ashton Archives* has been busy reclassifying their picture files. Many of the photos are now cross referenced. Maps from the 1920's which show the old buildings have been added. A donated microfiche reader will soon be ready for use.

Kathy Scow Newcomb, who wrote the "Ashton Family Histories" set of two books visited recently and made sure the Archives had copies to sell. Kathy is working on a third Ashton book! Anyone who missed having their family listed in the first set can contact Kathy through the Archives and find out how to be included in book three.

Helpers are *always* needed to work in the Archives! Jobs can last from an hour to a day depending on how involved you get with the work. Right now we need someone to check photograph books for mistakes. For someone who wants to visit while you work, we could use someone to clip tissue into various sizes, and the document files need checking and resorting.

For the person who would like to support the Archives but has no time, donations are gladly accepted. Margaret Howe has spent many hours working to get the photographs in order. Jan Seeley has been doing follow up work. Jane Daniels has been kept running helping people hunt for lost relatives and family history.

Because so many people are traveling through at different times, Jane has flexible hours. If the front curtains are open, the door is open, or you can see Jane's *spiffy* electric cart by the door, then the Archives are open.
