Recycling?

Ashton's recycling project is a huge success. Because of the volume of recycling material being collected, there are a few problems.

- #1: Please put only newspaper in the Newspaper bin, shinny advertizing sheets must go in the other paper bin.
- #2: Please put all cardboard, including fiber board, such as cereal and cracker boxes, non plastic egg cartons, and other lighter cardboard containers, in the Cardboard trailer. All cardboard must be broken down and flattened.
- #3: Plastic bags can go in with the other plastic. Please empty all material out of the plastic bags when depositing in the bins. Example; Plastic bag, full of paper, dumped in the paper bin.
- #4: Please do not leave any recycling material on the ground if the bins and cardboard trailer are full or gone.

The City and County are working together to schedule the best times to pick up and empty the trailers, this will vary depending on how heavy the usage. Please be considerate and only leave recycling material if the trailers are available.

We all can help make Ashton's recycling program a continuing success if we all take the time to separate, and put the recycling materials in the correct bins.
