The Henry's Fork Foundation is the only organization whose sole purpose is to conserve, protect, and restore the unique fisheries, wildlife, and aesthetic qualities of the Henry's fork and its watershed.

Since its beginnings decades ago, the **Henry's Fork Foundation** has truly become The Voice of the River through effective conservation programs led by expert staff and the support of thousands of members. The Foundation is The Voice of the River, its steward, its public educator, its researcher, and its scientific expert.

**Henry's Fork Foundation** has recently purchased the old hospital. It's been a storage place for many years, but they have recently remodeled it and were able to move in this month! It is a great facelift to the "old hospital". We at the Ashton Chamber of Commerce are excited for the **Henry's Fork Foundation** and we're happy for their contribution to improving the look of our down town.

The reason for the purchase and move, is that **Henry's Fork Foundation** has added more staff, more interns, and more graduate research students. Therefore, more space has become a necessity. **Henry's Fork Foundation** is also looking toward the future, planning for more growth. They want a place for an interpretive center for people to come visit and learn about the Henry's Fork and about the history of fly fishing. They would also like to provide displays of ecology of Henry's Fork, as well as demonstrate the history of the Henry's Fork as a working river with irrigation and hydro power production. Eventually, they will also be adding an intern dormitory.

**Henry's Fork Foundation** felt like this move would benefit the town. Their staff and board evaluated their needs and felt like purchasing the old hospital would help eliminate blight to our Main Street.

**Henry's Fork Foundation** had to do a lot of work on the "old hospital", including removing the asbestos and lead paint. They've done a beautiful job, and we encourage all to welcome their efforts in making something old into something new.

**Henry's Fork Foundation** really enjoy being a part of the Ashton community. We as the Chamber of Commerce appreciate them as members and all they do to help with community events. We are excited to see the old hospital property get cleaned up and looking more inviting to our Main Street, businesses, and community.

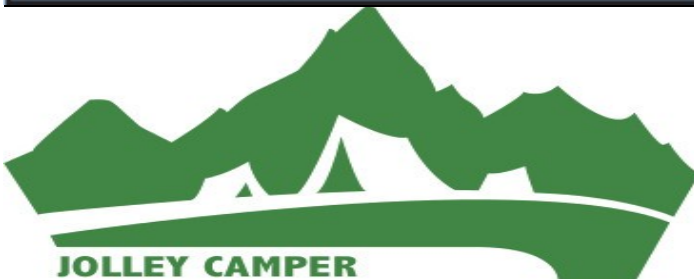
